Profile: School-Year 2021-2022



STUDENTS: ACS's student population of 917 is 97% Bulgarian (with 12% of students coming from outside Sofia), and 3% international students who represent 10 countries. There are 155 students in the Class of 2022. Admission to ACS for Bulgarians is based on an entrance examination taken in the spring of 7th grade in Bulgarian language, mathematics and analytical skills. Knowledge of English is not required. Students must have at least a 5.00 GPA to register for the entrance exam. In spring of 2021, 181 students out of the 705 who sat the entrance exam were offered admission to the College, an acceptance rate of 26%; 69% of them enrolled. Admitted students then spend a full "prep" year (8th grade) studying English. The 3% international students are admitted on the basis of an entrance exam, English proficiency and a strong academic record. Annual tuition is 7,200 Euros for the Bulgarian Diploma Program (for Bulgarian students) and 18,800 Euros for the international and IB Diploma Programs (for international students). ACS offers full scholarships to five Bulgarian students in each class, renewed annually, as well as tuition reduction for others; for the class of 2026, 87% of financial aid applications were approved. Out of 917 students, 26% currently receive tuition reduction.

STRUCTURE AND CURRICULUM:

All ACS courses are advanced college/universitypreparatory, as the pace and depth is necessary in order for them to achieve two diplomas, and 100% go on to college/university. (In addition, classes within a Profile are considered honors level.) All students earn the American Hiah School Diploma. In addition, Bulgarians earn the national Bulgarian Diploma, and international students earn the IB Diploma. ACS has five academic grades: grade (emphasizing intensive 8th "prep" or English training) and 9th-12th grades. All courses are taught in English except Bulgarian language literature, foreign languages, Bulgarian and geography and Bulgarian history. Bulgarian students choose a "profile", an area of concentration, within the Bulgarian Diploma Program (11th and 12th grades), in which students go into more depth. All ACS students follow an English profile and choose one other profile from the following: Humanities, Foreign Languages, Natural Sciences (biology and chemistry), Mathematics & Physics, Entrepreneurship, Software & Hardware. All ACS students take extra mathematics every year beyond the requirements of the Bulgarian curriculum.

GRADES AND RANKING-RATING POLICIES:

As a matter of policy, ACS does not rank or rate students. All academic courses receive grades of 2.00-6.00 according to the standards noted in the chart below. A 6.00 is the highest possible GPA. All academic courses are taught at an advanced college/ university-preparatory, honors level and students are required to maintain a 4.50 average or above. Students who earn a semester GPA of 5.50-5.89 are placed on the Honor Roll. Students with a GPA of 5.90-6.00 are placed on the President's List. In the event of a tie for highest GPA, the student with the most electives/credits is named Class Valedictorian at the end of the 12th grade year.

CREATIVITY-ACTION-SERVICE (CAS) PROGRAM and SENIOR INDEPENDENT HONORS PROJECTS (SIHP):

Following the IB CAS model, all ACS students are required to complete 75 hours of extracurricular involvement each year within the areas of creativity (planning and organization of projects), action (active involvement), and service-related activities. As seniors, students may choose to complete CAS and/or an SIHP (Senior Independent Honors Project) which requires a professional and a teacher sponsor, a research essay, and a presentation of the project's outcomes. Students who elect to complete a SIHP do work above and beyond ACS's graduation requirements.



HISTORY: The American College of Sofia (ACS) is one of the oldest American educational institutions outside the United States, tracing its roots to a boys' school founded in 1860 at Plovdiv and a girls' school founded in 1863 at Stara Zagora. The school was shut down in 1942 by the Bulgarian government and reopened its doors to a preparatory class of 100 students in September 1992. ACS is among the top private college preparatory schools in the Balkans. Admission is highly selective. Integrating the values and best practices of American pedagogy with the rich educational traditions of Europe, we seek to develop critical thinking, lifelong intellectual curiosity, leadership, and collaboration among multi-talented students of various social, cultural, economic, and geographic backgrounds. ACS graduates are accepted into some of the most prestigious universities in the U.S. and Europe and are valued critical thinkers and problem solvers able to set clear goals world-wide. We provide a rigorous university preparatory education to motivated young people and are fully accredited by the Bulgarian Ministry of Education and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, as well as the International Baccalaureate. Currently the IB Diploma Program is only available to non-Bulgarian international students. The majority of students receive both a Bulgarian diploma and an American diploma. The ACS curriculum is rigorous and all courses are taught in English at an advanced college/university preparatory, honors level.

ACCREDITATION: ACS is an approved secondary school under the auspices of the Bulgarian Ministry of Education, and all graduates receive Bulgarian diplomas, whether or not they have met ACS's criteria for the American diploma. ACS is fully accredited with the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools and the International Baccalaureate.
