School Mission: ACS integrates the values and best practices of American pedagogy with the rich educational traditions of Bulgaria and Europe. We seek to develop critical thinking, lifelong intellectual curiosity, leadership, and collaboration among multi-talented students of various social, cultural, economic, and geographic backgrounds.

Our Students: ACS is home to 954 students, Grades 8-12. Admission exam invitations are extended to candidates with GPA of 5.00 and above (21% of candidates held a 6.00 GPA in 2022, while the mid 50% GPA was 5.50-5.93). Admission is then offered based on Admission Exam rank. The average Acceptance Rate is highly selective (25.5% rate). ACS students score at the top of the National External Evaluation mandatory exams in Grades 10 and 12, as well as on the PSATs and the SATs. ACS students come from within and outside the capital city of Sofia and include International students. Central to our Mission, Financial Assistance supports over 1/3 of our students, ensuring an inclusive approach to acceptance and diversity within our student body.

A high GPA is important, but it is only one aspect of what we consider a meaningful educational experience. At ACS, we focus on developing not only excellent scholars, but also on cultivating the unique talents and curiosities of our students through a strong curricular and co-curricular experience.



**Our Faculty:** Faculty at ACS are distinguished professionals in their areas of expertise and come from a variety of cultural backgrounds: 12 hold Doctoral degrees and 81 hold Masters degrees. 40% of the faculty are International. ACS faculty provide a unique and enriching blend of pedagogies to support an International and Bulgarian curriculum.

**Curriculum:** ACS is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools (MSA), the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) and the Bulgarian Ministry of Education and Science, which designated the College an Innovative School in 2017. The rigorous curriculum at ACS provides Bulgarian students with a Bulgarian and an American (ACS) high school diploma. International students earn both an ACS diploma and an IB diploma. Our unique curriculum offers 6 specialized areas of study with advanced study profiles: Humanities, Foreign Languages, Math, Software & Hardware Sciences, Natural Sciences, and Entrepreneurship. The ACS high school diploma is accepted throughout the European Union and around the world.






## **Bulgarian & American Diploma Requirements**

At ACS Bulgarian and International students can acquire an American high school diploma by completing their Creativity, Activity & Service (CAS) Portfolios. Bulgarian and International students follow the same curriculum in Grades 9 & 10 and follow different curriculums in Grades 11 & 12: The Bulgarian students complete profile subjects, while the International students – the IB Program.
